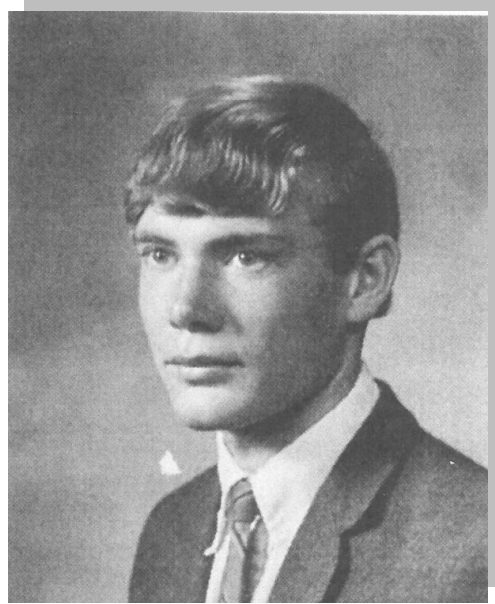


Clay Cameron Class of 1971



Clay Cameron's life was cut short due to a tragic car accident while he was a freshman at Southwest State University in 1971. He left behind a tremendous list of accomplishments. As a senior in 1971, he was all-state in track and field, finishing fourth place in the two-mile event at the state meet while establishing a new school record. He was also the District and Big Nine champion in the one mile. In cross country he was the District and Big Nine champion as well as being an individual participant in the state meet. As a junior in 1970, he was the District cross country champion as well a team participant in the state meet. In track and field, he was the district and Big Nine champion in the one mile. At the time, he also held the sophomore, junior and senior record for the one mile as well as the senior record for the two mile. He also held the cross country record for the three mile and the Hammer Field record for the one and two mile in track.
