



DOYLE FREEMYER graduated from Albert Lea High School in 1967, where he lettered four years in hockey, four years in track and field and three years in football. He lead the Tigers' hockey team in scoring his sophomore, junior and senior years including 20 goals and 15 assists his senior year. As a football player, he was the Tigers' second all-time leading rusher when he graduated with 747 yards and was named both All-Conference and All-State honorable mention. Doyle played football at Winona State his freshman year. Prior to starting his sophomore year, he volunteered for the draft and served two years in the Army, including 11 months in Vietnam.
