



LOWELL BRADY graduated from Albert Lea High School in 1956, where he participated in football, basketball and track, lettering seven times. His senior year in football he totaled 987 overall yards, gaining All-Conference recognition. Playing quarterback, he rushed 93 times for 529 yards and threw for 422 yards. He also returned kickoffs for 259 yards and two touchdowns and punted for the Tigers averaging 38.7 yards per punt.

He declined a football scholarship from Denver University and joined the U.S. Navy. After being honorably discharged, he played quarterback at Mankato State College, where he received three letters and was named the team's Most Valuable Player and was selected All-Conference.

Lowell and his wife, Sharon, and family reside in Greeley, Colorado.
