

BOBBY DOLAN exemplifies the multi-sport athlete. During his high school career he earned 13 letters in five sports: football, basketball, baseball, track and boxing. Bobby was the area Golden Gloves champion for his weight class. A gifted athlete, he combined blazing speed and great hand-eye coordination.

Bobby went on to college where he stared for St. Thomas in football and baseball. He cut his college career short when he signed with the Brooklyn Dodgers for \$15,000. He played nine seasons for the Dodgers organization, reaching the AAA playing status. Bobby died in 1989 at the age of 58 from ataxia (a disease of the central nervous system...similar to Lou Gehrig Disease).
