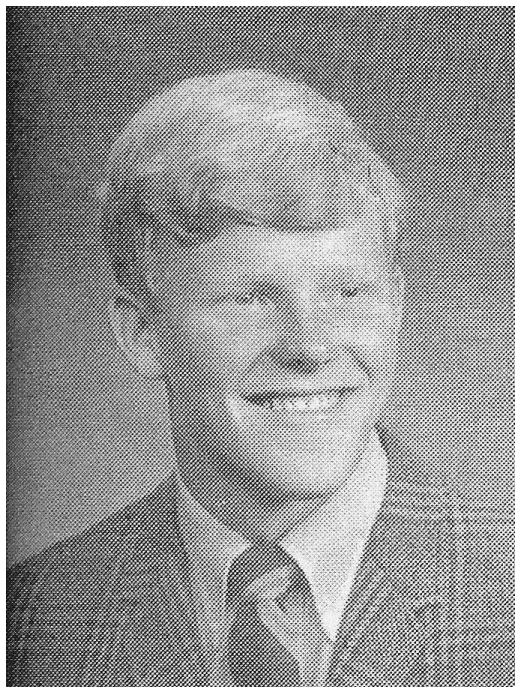


2011 ALHS Athletic Hall of Fame Inductee



Craig Dahl was a 1971 graduate of Albert Lea High School where he was a standout football and hockey player and hurdler.

As a football player, Dahl was named Big Nine All-Conference and All-State, and led the Big Nine in total passing yards.

As a hurdler, Dahl was the District 2 champion in the 120-meter high hurdles. As a hockey player, Dahl was elected to the Southern Minnesota All-Start League, was a Big Nine first-team defenseman and an All-State honorable mention.

Upon graduating from ALHS, Dahl received an athletic scholarship to the University of Minnesota football team in Minneapolis. He transferred to Pacific Lutheran University in Tacoma, Washington, and competed successfully in their football program.

Dahl went on to coach Division 1 men's hockey at St. Cloud State University.
