

MOLLEE (LUDTKE) TSCHOLL graduated from Albert Lea High School in 1994. While in high school, she lettered three times in volleyball and basketball and four times in track and field. She was two-time Big Nine All-Conference in volleyball and was first and second-team Big Nine All-Conference in basketball. At the time she finished her basketball career, she was the Tigers' fourth all-time leading scorer and third all-time leading rebounder. In track and field, she set the school record in the 800 meters. She was part of the 1600- and 3200-meter relay teams that hold the school record, as well as second all-time in the 400 meters at the time of graduation. At the state track and field meets, she had a sixth place finish in the 800, which got her All-State honors. She was also the anchor of the 3200-meter relay team at the state meet that finished third her junior year and second her senior year. She continued her career at Concordia College, where she was an All-American in track and field and set school records in the 600 meters indoor, the 800 meters and the 3200-meter relay race which stands as the MIAC Conference 3200-meter relay record.
